This scholarship includes full tuition and \$1,000 travel stipend for one current student or emerging professional from the Southeast Chapter states of Alabama, Georgia, Mississippi, South Carolina and Tennessee.

An eligible **Southeast Chapter Student** is a full-time student attending a 4 year or more undergraduate program or a graduate program at a school located in the Southeast Chapter states or a student whose permanent address is in the Southeast Chapter states.

An eligible **Southeast Chapter Emerging Professional** is an intern architect, interior designer, landscape architect, or craftsperson that is practicing in one of the Southeast Chapter states and is working toward licensure or someone that has earned their professional license since January 1, 2017.

It is the hope that this experience will allow the successful applicant to contribute to the continuum of the practice of classicism in the Southeast. The successful applicant will be requested to exhibit their work during the ICAA Southeast Chapter Toast to 2020 to be held in early January of 2020.
